- Understand the key sources of data currently used and analyse how it can be enhanced, finding new ways in which the data can be utilised to improve business performance.

- Work with the Reporting Manager and the wider IT and Innovation Directorate to recommend new systems and applications that will benefit the business.
- Work seamlessly with the wider Insight Team to turn data into actionable insight for the business.

- Undertake other activities from time to time as directed by the Head of Insight or Reporting Manager.
